## ADDITIONAL SUBCONTRACT FLOWDOWN TERMS FOR U.S. NAVY'S AST P-3 LIFE EXTENSION KITS, NO. 08-C-2392 \*

## 1. Add the following FAR Clauses:

**52.225-13 Restrictions on Certain Foreign Purchases** (FEB 2006) (Communication required under this clause from/to Seller to/from the Contracting Officer shall be through Lockheed Martin).

**52-246-15 Certificate of Conformance** (APR 1984) (Applicable if Seller will make direct shipments to the Government and there is no intervening acceptance by Lockheed Martin)

## 2. Add the following DFARS Clauses:

**252.215-7003 Excessive pass-through charges** – identification of subcontract effort (APR 2007) (This clause does not apply to subcontracts for commercial items)

**252.215-7004 Excessive pass-through charges** – identification of subcontract effort (APR 2007) (Applies unless this subcontract is fixed price, including fixed-price subcontracts with economic price adjustment, awarded on the basis of adequate price competition. Communications with the Contracting Officer under this clause shall be made through Lockheed Martin. In paragraph (e), the term "Contracting Officer" includes Lockheed Martin. If the Contracting Officer determines excessive pass-through charges are included in Seller's prices, Lockheed Martin shall make an adjustment to exclude such charges)

**252.225-7012 Preference for certain domestic commodities** (MAR 2008) (Applicable if Seller is furnishing any of the items covered by this clause)

**252.225-7030 Restriction on acquisition of carbon, alloy, and armor steel plates** (DEC 2006) (Applies if an order under this subcontract is for carbon, alloy, and armor steel plate in Federal supply class 9515, or described by American Society for Testing Materials (ASTM) or American Iron and Steel Institute (AISI) specifications)

**252.242-7005 Cost/Schedule Status Report** (MAR 2005) ("Government" and "Contracting Officer" means "Lockheed Martin.") (Not applicable to subcontracts for commercial items)

**252.243-7002 Requests for equitable adjustment** (MAR 1998) ("Government" means "Lockheed Martin") (Applies if this subcontract exceeds \$100,000)

**252.244-7000 Subcontracts for commercial items and Commercial Components (DoD Contracts)** (JAN 2007) (This clause applies only to the acquisition of commercial items)
