As presented in Table 1, Lockheed Martin considered two possible exposure scenarios for a basement screening level. The first scenario assumes that permanent employees spend an average of two hours per day, 250 days per year over the course of 25 years of employment. Under this scenario, the exposure time is reduced from 8 hours per day to 2 hours per day compared to the default worker scenario.

A second scenario considers a subcontractor employed in the basement for 8 hours per day, for 20
